

**12. Documentation for Joseph P. Gouty**  
**(06 January 1860 to 15 October 1939)**  
**father of Robert William Gouty**  
**(26 August 1889 to 04 June 1949)**

Joseph P. Gouty was born January 6, 1860, in Indiana.(1) He was the son of Elias B. Gouty and Elizabeth Shute.(2) Elias B. Gouty and Elizabeth Shute were married September 1, 1853, in Indiana.(3)

On September 28, 1882, Joseph P. Gouty married Mary Luella Hartman in Danville, Vermilion County, Illinois.(4) Mary Luella Hartman was born July 21, 1863, in Illinois.(5) The parents of Mary Luella Hartman were William Hartman and Elizabeth Nicholas (Nichols, Nichlas).(6)

William Hartman and Elizabeth Nicholas were married October 19, 1862, in Vermillion County, Indiana.(7) A William Hartman is listed in the 1860 U. S. Census for Indiana, Vermillion County, Highland Township.(8) Elizabeth Nicholas was 20 years old and living in the household of her parents in 1860.(9)

Elizabeth (Nicholas) Hartman died November 23, 1866, about four years after she married William Hartman.(10) It appears that the parents of Elizabeth, William Nicholas and his wife Mahala Shute, raised Mary Luella Hartman after Elizabeth died. William Hartman, the father of Mary Luella Hartman, did not die until May 31, 1896, when he was 70 years old.(11)

Mahala Shute was an older sister of Elizabeth Shute, the wife of Elias B. Gouty. The 1870 U. S. Census for Indiana, Vermillion County, Highland Township, lists William Nicholas, age 61, and Mahala, age 53. Mary Luella Hartman, age 6, born in Illinois, is listed in the William Nicholas household.(12) Mary Luella Hartman also is listed in the 1880 William Nicholas household.(13)

Joseph P. Gouty and Luella Mary Hartman were the parents of six children:(14)

Rose Ann Gouty was born February 21, 1884. She married Everett Willard Remster on December 15, 1906. She died November 14, 1961.

Ezra Gouty was born January 10, 1886, and died June 26, 1957.

Robert William Gouty was born August 26, 1889, in Gessie, Vermillion County, Indiana.(15) Robert married Ethel Belle Fox on February 2, 1917.(16) He died June 4, 1949, in Lakeview Hospital, Danville, Vermilion County, Illinois, and is buried at the Lower Mound Cemetery west of Covington, Indiana.(17)

Ida Fae and Inez Mae Gouty were twins born May 17, 1897. Inez died July 29, 1977. She never married. Ida Fae Gouty died April 11, 1979. She married Dewey Saltgaver. They did not have any children.

Leslie Roy Gouty was born August 7, 1892.

Mary Luella (Hartman) Gouty died June 23, 1938, in Foster, Warren County, Indiana.(18) Joseph P. Gouty died October 15, 1939, in Danville, Vermilion County, Illinois.(19) Both Mary Luella and Joseph P. Gouty are buried in Hopewell Cemetery west of Covington, Indiana.(20)

Joseph P. Gouty acquired a number of small farms in Warren County, Indiana. These farms were distributed to his children upon his death. The property was distributed such that each child received relatively more land if there was no house on the property.(21) Robert William Gouty was executor of the Joseph P. Gouty estate.(22)

Joseph Gouty appears in a number of U. S. Census records for Vermillion and Warren Counties in Indiana. Joseph Gowty (i.e., Gouty) is listed in the Elias Gowty (i.e., Gouty) household in the 1860 U. S. Census for Indiana, Vermillion County, Highland Township, Post Office Perrysville. He is listed as five months old (age 5/12 of a year) and his birthplace is Indiana.(23) Joseph Gouty also appears in the Elias B. Gouty household in the 1870 U. S. Census for Indiana, Vermillion County, Highland Township, Post Office Perrysville. His age at that time is given as 10.(24) Joseph Gouty also appears in the Elias Gouty household in the 1880 U. S. Census for Indiana, Vermillion County, Highland Township. His age at that time is given as 20.(25)

The 1900 U. S. Census for Indiana, Warren County, Mound Township, lists the Joseph Gouty household. Joseph Gouty is listed as 40 years old in 1900, born in January 1861 in Indiana, father born in Ohio, mother born in Indiana, race is white, and gender is male; Mary L. Gouty is listed as born in July 1863 in Illinois, father born in Indiana and mother born in Indiana; children listed are Rose A, Ezra E., Robert W., Roy L., Inez F., and Ida M. Robert is listed as age 10, born in August 1889. (26)

The 1910 U. S. Census for Indiana, Warren County, Mound Township, lists the Joseph Gouty household. Joseph Gouty is listed as 50 years old in 1910, born in Indiana, race is white, gender is male.(27)

The 1920 U. S. Census for Indiana, Warren County, Mound Township, ED #207, lists the Joseph Gouty household. Joseph Gouty is listed as 60 years old in 1920, born in Indiana, and his race is white.(28) The 1930 U. S. Census for Indiana, Warren County, Mound Township, ED #8, lists the Joseph F. (P.) Gouty household. Joseph F. Gouty is listed as 70 years old in 1930, born in Indiana, race is white.(29)

Children (**Gouty**), born in Indiana:(30)

i. **Rose Ann**, born February 21, 1884, she married Everett Washburn Remster on December 15, 1906, in Fountain County, Indiana. He was born November 9, 1907, and he died in October 1981. She died November 14, 1961. A son was Raymond Remster. He owned 25 acres of land next to the Robert William Gouty farm of 40 acres in Warren County, Indiana, according to Mavis Lorene Gouty.

ii. **Ezra**, born January 10, 1886, and died June 26, 1957

iii. **Everett**, born October 18, 1887, and died October 24, 1895, buried at Hopewell Cemetery, Vermillion County, Indiana

iii. **Robert William**, born August 26, 1889, and died on June 4, 1949, in Danville, Vermilion County, Illinois. He married Ethel Belle Fox on February 3, 1917. Buried at Lower Mound Cemetery, Highland Township, Vermillion County, Indiana.

iv. **Ida Fae**, born May 17, 1897, in Foster, Warren County, Indiana. She married Dewey L. Saltgaver on March 16, 1919.

v. **Inez Mae**, born May 17, 1897, and died July 29, 1977, in Covington, Fountain County, Indiana. She and Ida Fae were twins. Buried at Hopewell Cemetery.

vi. **Roy Leslie**, born August 7, 1892, in Covington, Fountain County, Indiana, and died July 16, 1963, in Danville, Vermilion County, Illinois

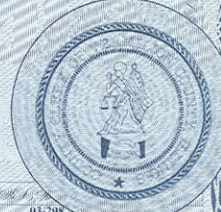

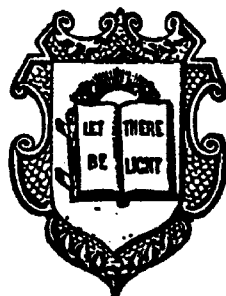

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF JOSEPH P. GOUTY

I, Joseph P. Gouty, of Warren County, Indiana, hereby declare this to be my last will and testament, revoking any former will heretofore made.

Item 1:

I hereby will and devise that all my just debts, last sickness expenses, if any, including doctor bills, if any, and funeral expenses be paid as soon as shall be convenient after my death.

Item 2:

I will, devise and bequeath to my beloved wife, M. Luella Gouty, all of my personal property and real estate, that I may die seized of, to have and hold for and during her natural life time, subject to any of my indebtedness, if any.

Item 3:

After the death of my said wife, I will, devise and give to my daughter, Anna Remster, the fee simple in and to the following described real estate in Warren County, Indiana:

The south half of the east half of the southwest quarter of Section nineteen (19), Township twenty (20) north, range nine (9) west, containing forty (40) acres, more or less.

to have and hold during her natural life, and at her death to go to and be the real estate of her son, Raymond L. Remster.

Item 4:

After the death of my said wife, I will, devise and bequeath to my son, Ezra E. Gouty, to have and hold absolutely, the following described real estate in Warren County, Indiana:

I Joseph P. Gouty of Warren County, Indiana, hereby declare this to be the first codicil to my last will and testament, executed on the 8th day of September, 1934.

Whereas, by Item Two of said will I devised all my real estate to my beloved wife, M. Louella Gouty, and she having died prior to this date, I hereby revoke and cancel said Item Two; and

Whereas, by Item Three of said last will I devised to Anna Remster a life estate in forty (40) acres in Section Nineteen, Township Twenty north, Range nine west in Warren County, Indiana, with the fee simple therein to her son, Raymond L. Remster; I now revoke said bequest in full and make the change hereinafter set forth.

I hereby ratify and confirm Item Four of said will and I confirm and ratify Item Five of my said last will and I also ratify and confirm Item six thereof, hereby dividing the fee simple in said tracts of real estate set out in said Items, Four, five and six immediately at my death. I do also ratify and confirm Item Seven of my said will, giving to Ida Mae Saltgaver, a life estate in the lands described therein: And

Whereas, by Item Eight of said will, I devised to my daughter, Inez Fay Gouty, certain real estate in Warren County, Indiana, I now revoke said Item Eight and make the change as hereinafter set forth.

**#8: JAMES GRANT OLDER**

1<sup>st</sup> paragraph: The death certificate is nice proof of James' parentage, as is the 1870 census. (Just an observation, but you just never find little Southern boys named "Grant" or "Sherman!")

4<sup>th</sup> paragraph: The last sentence reads "James...and Wilhelmina...were the parents of three children....but citation #6 is for Roy's death certificate. Wrong place for this citation? It does not prove the three children.

Paragraphs 5 and 6 refer to the other children of James and Anna, but there are no citations for the information given.

There should be more citation numbers in the last paragraph. Number nine would be for the 1870 census; then succeeding numbers for the next censuses. Again, the 1940 census has not been released and should not be cited.

I did not see the 1910 census cited for James and Wilhelmina Older. In case you don't have it, here it is: 1910 IL, Macon Co., Decatur, 6<sup>th</sup> ward, Sheet 10A, ED117, p. 35, 226/271: James J. (note initial) Older, 46, born IL; Minnie, 43, 3 children, all living; Nellie, 21; Mabel, 17; Mayme Findlay, 20, roomer.

**#11: LUCY JANE HARMISON**

We have, of course, discussed Lucy Jane before, with the "Doctor Dillon" controversy. What a mystery in 1870: Where was Lucy Jane? Boarding school? Perhaps working in another household? I couldn't locate her in any indices. Your proofs for this file are very good. No problems.

**#12: JOSEPH P. GOUTY**

1<sup>st</sup> paragraph: Don't forget your period after the "P" in Joseph's middle name; also in the first citation! (I'm subbing in English this week, can't you tell?) Good citations for his birth and proof of parentage: Bible records, tombstone and childhood listings in censuses.

The paragraph concerning the estate of Joseph is very good; it would be so helpful if every ancestor had such a nice listing of “heirs” and a good will/probate record!

Be sure to cite the 1900 census, as described in son Robert’s section of this report. Note that Joseph and wife Mary actually had seven children by 1900; one was deceased, according to the census report.

Do you have the 1880 census for Joseph and Mary Gouty? I did not see it cited. I tried to locate Joseph, but could not find him. Perhaps the Gouty name was completely butchered by the census taker. I could not find it with soundex, either. If you have tried to locate it and cannot find it, you might want to mention that in your narrative.

**#13: MARY LUELLE HARTMAN**

Should this person be called Mary Luella Hartman or Luella M. Hartman? Your file calls her the former; your ahnentafel lists her as the latter.

Mary Luella was born during the tumultuous Civil War. Was her father a soldier? From the date of her brother Ezra’s birth (age 3 in 1870), I, too, suspect that their mother may have died in childbirth. There was just enough time at the end of the Civil War for Ezra to have been conceived and born, if William Hartman went to war and returned in 1865. As it turns out, there are no less than 8 William Hartmans who either served in Indiana units during the war, or who resided in Indiana. The list is enclosed. I have no idea if one of these is the correct William Hartman, but thought you would be interested. [Enclosed]

Your census proofs for Mary Luella are good. You establish her mother’s parentage; also, one of the censuses refers to Mary Luella as the granddaughter of William and Mahala. In 1870, due to Civil War era deaths, it was very common for households to combine (usually widows with children) or for relatives to take in orphaned family members. So many women died in childbirth in those days, many grandparents raised their grandchildren, unless the father of the children remarried quickly.

Again, in this file, although other middle initials are followed by periods, there is no period in Joseph P.’s middle initial. You might want to correct that, for the sake of consistency. Under reference #2, Mary L. Hartman’s age was omitted and “Age” was capitalized.

Can you obtain a copy of the death certificate for Mary Luella Hartman? Since you have both her death date and place, and the year was comparatively recent (1938), one should be available. It would be a nice back-up to the Bible record.
